If requirements are not completed, including the required teacher evaluations, the lateral license is no longer valid. If teacher obtained a "Licensure Only Plan" through NC Regional Alternative Licensing Center (RALC) on their own in the last three years, teacher must be evaluated before the "Licensure Only Plan" expires. Teacher must contact EESLPD Unit if he/she falls into this category. There is a fee for licensure paid to the NCDPI-Licensure Section.	Provisional licenses may <u>not</u> be reinstated. **NC Pre-K teacher education/licensure requirement for any teacher in public or nonpublic pre-k programs. The BK SP II is attainable through an approved Beginning Teacher Support Program (BTSP), offered by the EESLPD for nonpublic NC Pre-K teachers and for teachers employed by public schools of North Carolina. All NC Pre-K teachers who work in <u>nonpublic</u> schools must be enrolled with the EESLPD Unit and complete orientation and evaluation training to begin and to maintain licensure requirements. To qualify for enrollment in the EESLPD, teachers must have at least a BA/BS degree in early childhood, child development or a related field (psychology or human development/family studies).
